Complete the enclosed form requesting a class and send it to me. I will review it before sending it to Tom Starr. I will also have it posted to the SYSL website <http://sysl.com/>.

The host is to attend each class with the instructor at all times, and supply the items the instructor needs to conduct the class. The host is responsible for the behavior of students in the class and is expected to deal with any issue as requested by the instructor. Class size will be around 30 students.

A check made out to SYSL for \$60.00 is collected by the host from each student. A fee must be received for the student before they are issued the law book and the procedure manual that is provided. The student's check will be refunded on the final night if the student passes the test. For participants that come from other "leagues" SYSL will keep the \$60.00 check.

Different clubs in SYSL "host" the Referee clinics, SYSL will pay the initial \$270.00 to set up the Entry Level classes.

Certification is good for one year. Participants must pay following years fees if they want to keep up their referee certifications. These are automatically mailed to you by the end of the certification year.

SYSL Clubs wishing to host an **in-service** class must notify the Head Referee. SYSL will pay the in-service fee of \$100.00. This is a one evening class.
