## 2009–2010 STANDINGS POLICY AND PROCEDURES

### For Managers and Club Representatives

SYSL's goal is to set an atmosphere where children participate in friendly competition in which sportsmanship, learning and playing soccer are held first. Standings are an important component to fulfilling that goal as game scores determine whether a team has been successfully placed in a certain division. If there has been a gross misseeding, accurate standings are essential to rectify the situation. Because there are over 500 teams in our league, accurate and timely Standings Reports are necessary.

#### **IMPORTANT CLUB REQUIREMENTS!!**

SYSL has a web-based program for reporting all game scores. Each Club Standings Representative must contact the SYSL Standings Coordinator to get instructions on how to set up your Club's password. Once your password has been assigned, go to the SYSL website, ([www.SYSL.com](http://www.SYSL.com)) and click on the "Game Report" link.

#### **"GAME REPORT" PROCEDURES:**

1. All Club Standings Representatives must report their scores each week, including byes, forfeits, cancellations, and make up games, by 12 noon on Monday, except for the week ending October 4. **For the weekend ending October 10, all scores must be turned in by 6pm on Saturday, October 10,** so that re-seeding for the second half can begin immediately.
2. Any scores that need to be added (make up game, etc), or mistakes to be corrected after the Monday, 12-noon deadline must be emailed directly to the SYSL Standings Coordinator. The Game Report does not allow Club Standings Representative to edit their reports after 12-noon on Monday.
3. There will be a note field provided at the end of your weekly report to indicate any red cards received by your club, or to use if you have any notes relating to games played that week.

#### **FINES:**

1. The club will be fined \$10.00 for each team not reporting their score each week.
2. If a club fails to report their scores on any given weekend, the offending Club will be fined \$100.00 for each week failing to report scores.

#### **Please Note:**

Metro teams and CPL teams have other methods of reporting their teams' scores.
