There will be a meeting on August 26<sup>th</sup> to prepare the Coaches packets. Volunteers needed to put these together.

### (HEAD COACH REPORT:

Steve reported on the goal keepers' clinic to be held August 19<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup>. Up to 2 keepers are permitted with the coach on the 21<sup>st</sup>. The meeting on the 19<sup>th</sup> is for the Coaches.

A thank you was offered to Steve of his help for setting up the Clinics.

A request was made to have Clinics in December. A guarantee would be needed of at least 20 coaches attending to reserve an instructor.

### (HEAD REFEREE REPORT):

Don submitted a list for the Coaches of the certified referees. Please review and update as needed.

Parkway hosted a clinic, 14 attended with 9 passing.

Woodland had 20 attend with 17 passing.

Greenhaven had 21 attend, with 19 passing.

Dixon had 9 attend, with 6 passing, and LandPark had 29 attend with 25 passing.

Less than 50% of participants were adults and more adults are needed.
