SYSL BOARD OF MANAGER'S MEETING

July 8, 2003

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:53 p.m.

ROLL CALL:

Sign In sheet not returned so no report for attendance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Tom Bistline not to accept minutes as posted. Dave Buno sec.

VISITOR:

Shannon Breckenridge new board member from Clarksburg, and Candace, a Club Registrar.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

No report. Janice will be hosting for the President who is absent this evening.

(HEAD COACH REPORT:

GH clinic has filled up and has a waiting list.

Dixon has 11 coaches signed up, room for up to 30. Clinic to be held Aug 1 and 2

Sept 19 and 21 is a goalkeeper's clinic. Friday night for coaches and Sat bring goalkeepers.

Ques: Is there a limit to the number of children that can attend.

We have not received a figure, but we should try not to overwhelm the class with a lot of attendees. Probably one goalkeeper per coach.

Parkway is hosting and there is a limit of 25 coaches. This is being advertised on the District website so let's try to get as many of our SYSL coaches in the class as we can.

Positive Coaching clinic has brought up some additional expenses which were not noticed at presentation and there is a concern if we wish to honor this contract.

The revised contract is asking for cost of travel and board for the instructor and an additional fee for every manager, \$5 ea.

Kathy has had several discussions with the company along with Ross. Kathy disagrees with our having to pay these additional costs. Ross explained that this revised contract does cover cost

not additionally proposed and Positive Coaching is not going to be charging us for these added expenses. The cost of travel would not apply as the instructors are coming from the local area. The \$5.00 per manager fee is for manuals. The manager's would not have to purchase the manuals, but it does provide good information. Vonnie from Clarksburg Club had attended a class and she recommends purchasing the manual.

Ross did agree that there was some misrepresentation, but this has been cleared up. There will be a \$2600.00 cost to SYSL for clinic, plus two workshops.

As a club will there be a \$400.00 cost for the class plus \$5.00 fee which is for the manual. The leadership class will be provided a manual for free, the coaches' clinics will be charged for the manual.

Ross said GH tentatively set dates for 7/21 for leadership, at Lisbon elementary school in 7/23 and 8/13 for the coaches.

Vonnie Powell mot to accept the terms set my Ross, second my Alan Whisenand, 1 opposition, 5 abstentions. Mot passes.
