## **SYSL Board Meeting July 10, 2007**

### **CALL TO ORDER:**

Meeting called to order at 7:35 p.m.

### **ROLL CALL:**

### **VISITORS:**

The Greenhaven Metro Girls U14 Panthers were on site to assist with serving dinner. The team was undefeated in league play last year. GOOD JOB GIRLS!!!

### **APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

Motion to approve the minutes made by Land Park and seconded by Greenhaven. The motion passed unanimously with changes as recommended.

### **FIRST VICE REPORT:**

Sarah Najarro provided copies of the PAD procedures being considered for amendment. Don began by explaining how PAD Committee currently proceeds. The Referee files a report with the PAD Committee following a game. The PAD Committee then determines the suspension. The PAD committee has allowed coaches and players to come before the committee to provide feedback.

The recommendation is to change the current procedures to allow the PAD Committee to meet without these presentations. The player or coach could protest the report in writing but will not be present at the hearing. PAD Committee will determine the appropriate penalty and it will be final. This pertains only to the recreational teams.

Motion to approve the changes to the PAD Committee procedures was made by Tami Chloger and seconded by Robert Marin.

A vote was taken with ten approving, three opposed and two abstentions. The motion passed.

### **HEAD COACH REPORT:**

Steve Martinez provided information on the upcoming clinics. The next "F" Clinic will be held August 17 & 18<sup>th</sup>. This is a nine hour course over a Friday and Saturday. The Goalkeepers Clinic will be held August 24 & 25<sup>th</sup> at Our Lady of Guadalupe. This is also a nine hour course over a Friday and Saturday.

Steve provided a reminder that each coach must have a valid "F" license for one playing season prior to applying for the "E" license. Greenhaven and Land Park will work with Steve to find a time in early 2008 for an "E/D" Clinic. If you have any coaches that would be interested in this course please let Steve know early.

### **HEAD REFEREE REPORT:**

Don Spicklemeir reported that there is a Land Park clinic currently on-going at McClatchy High School. Land Park will host another clinic beginning August 9<sup>th</sup> at McClatchy. This is the last clinic scheduled for this year.

West Sacramento has a clinic scheduled for July 17<sup>th</sup> at Alice Norman School. Sammy Savala is hosting this clinic and he can be contacted for more information.

### **TREASURER'S REPORT:**

### **METRO REPORT:**

Sarah Najarro reported that a Metro meeting was held last week. Two teams have dropped. A U-16 girls team from Woodland and a U-12 team from Tahoe Park. There were issues with the Coaches licenses. Metro seeding is scheduled for July 28, 2007.

### **REGISTRAR'S REPORT:**

Jennifer Neuner reported that July 7<sup>th</sup> was the deadline for Metro teams to register. She received several on that day and many of them had issues. Players must not have baseball caps and sunglasses they will be rejected. Takes too much time. Dixon coach did not send in licenses. Possession of the license must be validated. If it is not submitted, the application will be denied. With every change that is made to the roster, a new goldenrod must be created. A new goldenrod must be turned in with each change. This could delay game play as the goldenrod is necessary to check-in teams.

An explanation is required by Coaches who marked YES for the background checks on the application or it will be returned.

Team names cannot duplicate each other to the adjacent years. A club may have teams with the same name, outside of adjacent years, as long as it is qualified with the year (ie: Atlas '95, Atlas '97, etc.)

Registration is down. Registrars are asking for more forms, but no one is submitting them. West Sacramento and Land Park registrations have increased.

Lamination nights have been emailed to the registrars.

**COMMITTEE REPORT:**

Valley Hi, Parkway & East Sac have received permits. School permit applications were handed in last week. Hope will need a list of seeding reps from the clubs. This is necessary by next meeting.

Teams are ranked against coaches experience, length of time players have been playing and how long they have played together, etc. Computer program offers assistance for the seeding process.

**GOOD OF GAME:**

Tami Cholger reported the U-12 girls team won the US Club Regional and had the opportunity to participate in the National Cup in North Carolina. The team will not attend as the cost is \$15,000. Two weeks later the team played Cal Cup and won. There were seven State team players and five were chosen for regional camp.

The cost for the regional camp is \$950 per player with an additional \$200 if the players are held over. Tami requested Good of Game funds for these girls.

Motion made by Hope Anaya to grant \$100 for the each of the five girls.

The vote was 15 approved, 1 opposed and 2 abstentions.

The motion passed.
