

SYSL Annual General Meeting

Tuesday April 12, 2011

CALL TO ORDER:

Meeting called to order at 7:42 by Marlene Vega, SYSL president

ROLL CALL: All present. Land Park hosted and introduced its board. Guests: Jeff from Live Scan (see more info under "New Business") and "The Candy Man", Tim Rickard, made presentations for their products.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Motion to approve made by West Sac, seconded by Woodland. Motion passed unanimously.

FIRST VICE REPORT:

If registered coach can't be at a game, there won't be a game (no longer can a parent just step in to coach with a driver's license). Up to four coaches can be registered to any one team (so register a couple of parents as emergency coaches). If game is not played, then it should be rescheduled.

HEAD COACH REPORT:

The upcoming "F" clinic is already full and the "E" has just two spots left. We could put on an E/D clinic or a GK (Goalkeeper) clinic if there's enough interest. The next available "F" clinic is scheduled for June 3-4 in River Park. Check the website for details and registration information.

Land Park volunteered to host a goalkeeper clinic at the end of August.

There will be a "D" clinic in Rocklin the first two weeks in June (3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12)

HEAD REFEREE REPORT:

We've held one ref class of 30 students, hosted by the SSA.

Jessica Bowen, SYSL Female Referee of the Year, will be refereeing in the State Cup Finals.

Costs for referee classes have gone up for this year. SYSL students will need to bring two checks – one for \$40 and the other for \$20 (they will get the \$20 back when they pass the course). It will cost non-SYSL students \$60.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

Elizabeth passed around the proposed budget for 2011-2012. After some discussion, Land Park motioned to approve with a West Sac second. It was passed unanimously.

REGISTRAR'S REPORT:

Jennifer has met with the Club registrars. They can start registering players for the new season now. The CYSA 1628 forms (coaches/other adults) can be done online with electronic signatures. Pictures can be uploaded. Go to the CYSA website.

SECRETARY'S REPORT:

Greenhaven will host the next meeting at the Elk's Lodge.

We still need one club to host for the month of August.

PRESIDENT'S REPORT:

Cherry Island contract is coming to an end with CYSA. We are hoping it gets renewed. The contract is currently out for bid and it's between us and another organization. Please participate in the letter writing campaign. (instructions in an email sent to Club Managers)

COMMITTEE REPORT:

CCSL – Teams can be registered through the website. Metro is going away.

OLD BUSINESS:

Teams presented uniforms. Southgate and Clarksburg both have yellow; Woodland and West Sac both have orange; East Sac and Parkway both have red. When teams from these clubs play each other, the Home team must wear pinnies or alternate jerseys.

NEW BUSINESS:

CYSA is pushing for "Pre-F" coaches clinics.

Live Scan – Finger print background checks. \$10 per coach/adult and only once while that coach is with that club. Response time is within 72 hours. If it is done by the league, it would cover the individual clubs and cover a coach who might move clubs. There was quite a bit of discussion and there seemed to be some interest.
